Jolene - As part of Creative Development for Clogher Valley SureStart, I was really looking forward to discovering new ways of exploring the creativity that lies within each child as a unique individual.

This involved engaging in new processes and learning to read and translate 100 languages of children. Experiencing the Ateleir and meeting the Ateleirista was amazing, they displayed many invitations and demonstrated the process of how the child constructs their own learning, it was a one of my highlights companied with a trip to the 'Remida' a centre full of recycled materials already to be brought back to life by a child.
